



## The 2017 Lucretia Van Horn Memorial Art Award

**THEME:** “Fantasy and Folklore”

**PURPOSE:** Lucretia Van Horn was a gifted artist and educator who worked with other noted artists such as Diego Rivera, Pablo O’Higgins, and David Park to teach others an appreciation for beauty through art. To honor her legacy, her grandson and former administrator of the Cupertino Union School District, Van Adams, and his family created the Lucretia Van Horn Memorial Fund.

The purpose of this endowment is to celebrate the arts by recognizing outstanding middle school artists in the Cupertino Union School District.

First Prize:	\$250
Second Prize:	\$100
Third Prize:	\$50

**GUIDELINES:**

- This competition is open to any student attending a CUSD middle school.
- Only 1 (one) entry per student please.
- The Entry Form must be attached to the back of your entry and written legibly.
- Artwork should express your interpretation of the theme.
- Artwork should be two-dimensional only.
- Artwork can be of any media or combination of media.
- Artwork should not exceed 18” X 20”.
- Artwork must be original and completed entirely by the student.

Entries will be judged on creativity, mastery of the medium, and theme development.

Winners will be announced by no later than 5/15/17, and formally will be presented with their award at the CUSD Board of Trustees meeting on 5/23/17.
